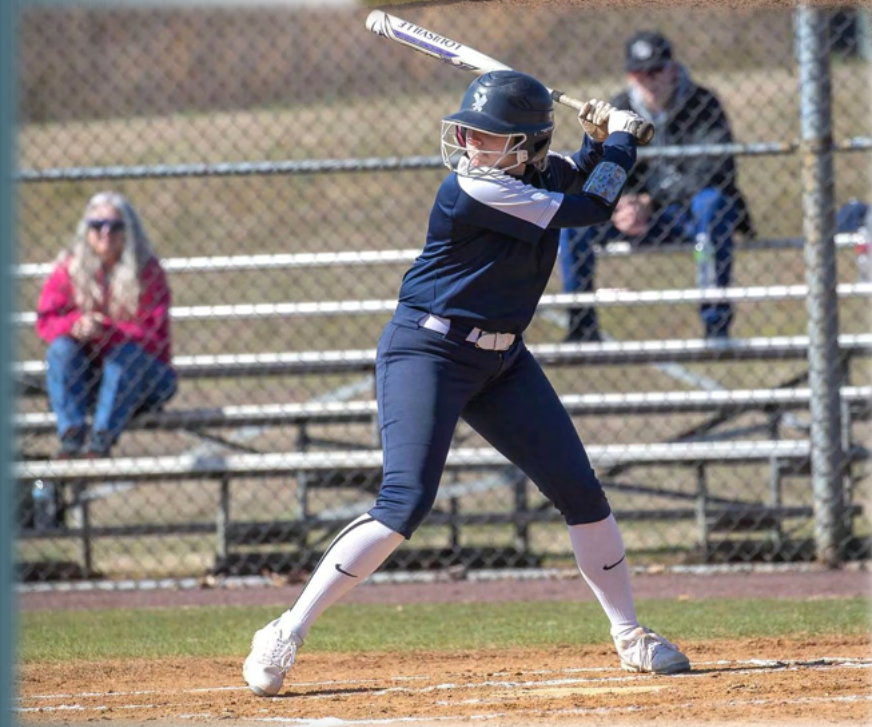
Division III Institutions
